

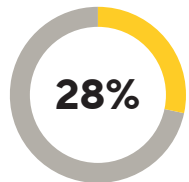

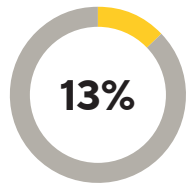
% BREAKDOWN OF

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION



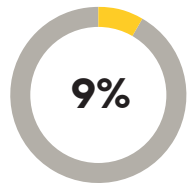

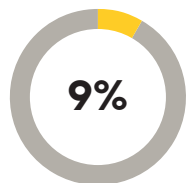

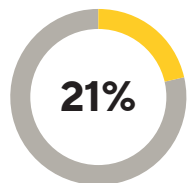

Countries and continents have been grouped following the official UN classification, except for Cyprus, which has been listed under Europe.





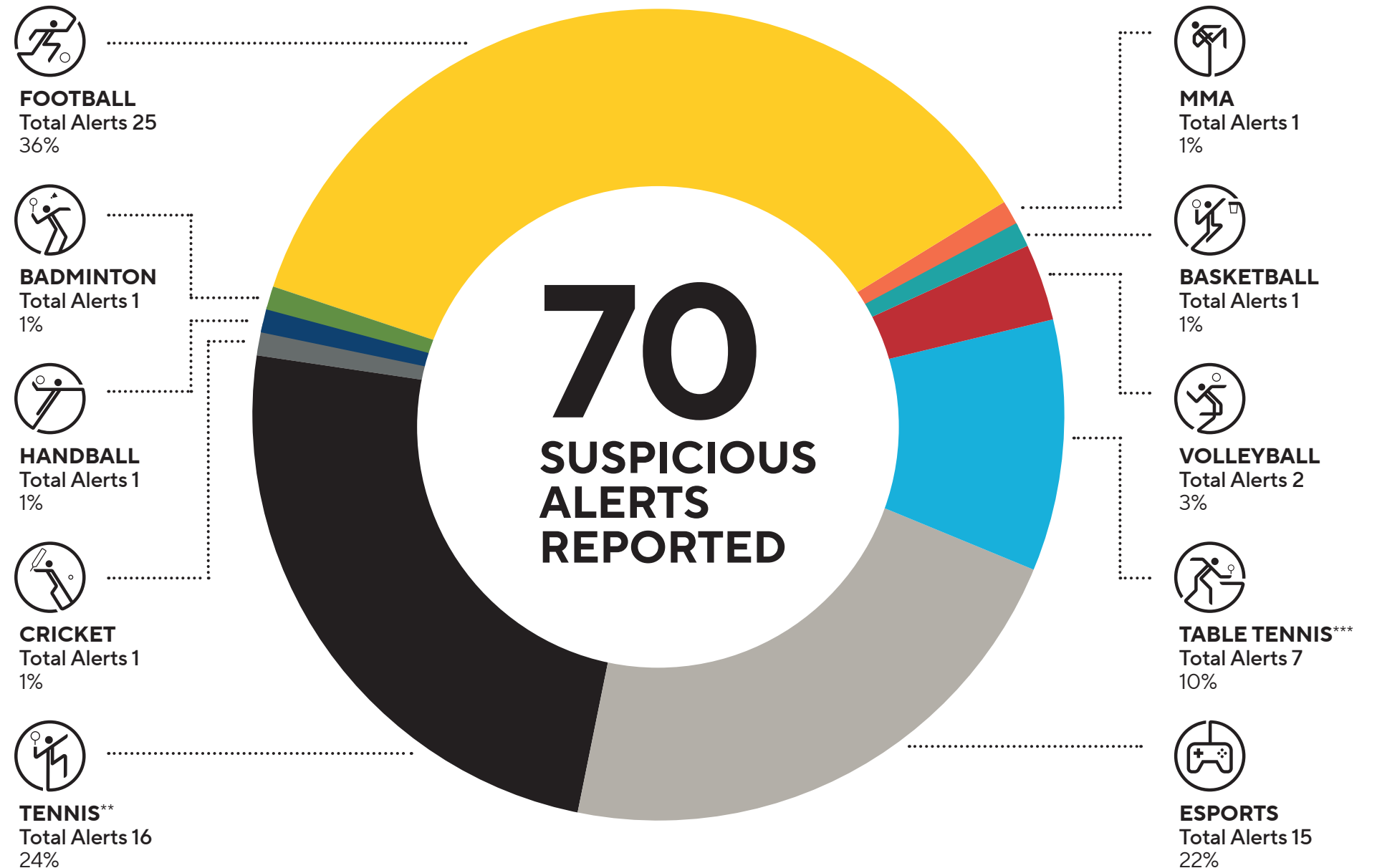
ALERTS

* This figure may be revised depending on the outcome of any ongoing investigations.

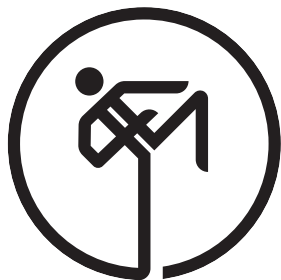

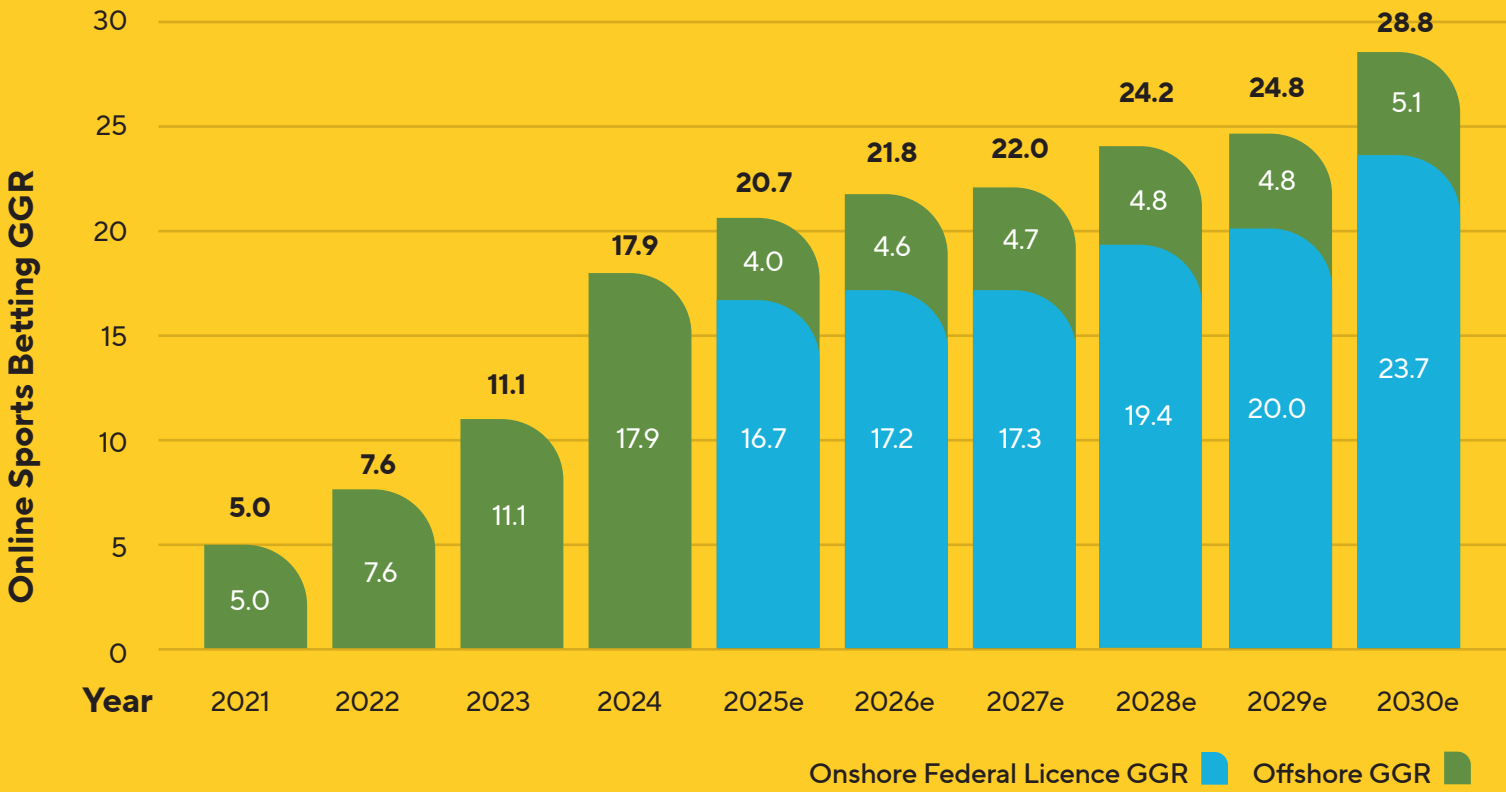
Suspicious Alerts Reported

From 2021 to 2025, 68 suspicious betting alerts were reported in Brazil covering 8 sports: Football (51), Basketball (6), Tennis (6), Volleyball (1), Beach Volleyball (1), Futsul (1), Table Tennis (1) and Sinuca Americana (1).



Online Sports Betting GGR (BRLbn)

Brazil’s online sports betting market is forecast to see a structural shift from offshore to onshore regulated activity following the introduction of federal licensing in 2025. Total sports betting market gross gambling revenue (GGR) is forecast to expand steadily, reaching BRL 28.8bn (US\$4.7bn) by 2030, with onshore federally licensed operators accounting for over 80% of GGR.

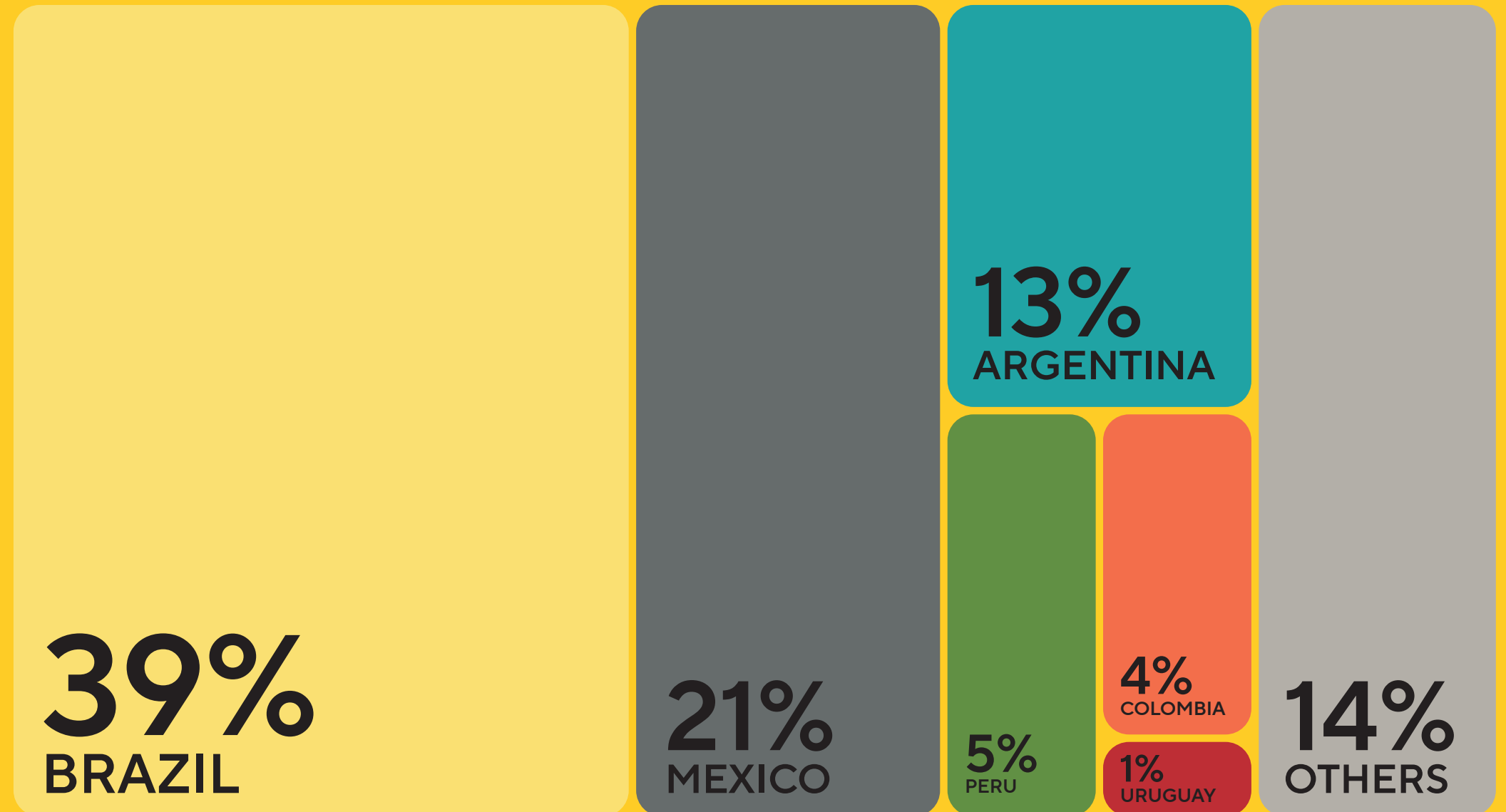
LatAm Betting GGR Market Share Forecast for 2026

Brazil is projected to dominate the LatAm total land-based and online betting market in 2026, accounting for 39% of total gross gambling revenue (GGR).

Brazil's GGR is forecast to be nearly double the size of Mexico's overall betting GGR (21%), followed by Argentina (13%). Those three countries are forecast to account for over 70% of the total LatAm market.
